EVENT: CSSA sanctioned, Junior Regatta. One day, five races scheduled, one race makes a regatta.

FLEETS: Optimist, Sunfish, Laser, Club 420, Multi-hull (including Hobie 14, Hobie 16, and Prindle16).

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all persons who do not turn 19 years of age during calendar year 2017. Optimists are sailed in two fleets: Green Fleet-Open to all novice sailors; and Red Fleet-experienced sailors. Maximum Skipper age in Optimist fleets is 15. Membership in CSSA is required.

FEES: Registration Fee is \$15.00. Fees include lunch and dinner for participants.

Directions from Wichita: Drive west 25 miles on highway US 54. Turn north on highway 251 and drive 3.4 miles to 21st street. Turn west on 21st street and drive 3.4 miles to Cheney State Park entrance. Turn north and follow the regatta signs to Ninnescah Sailing Association.

REGISTRATION. Registration at the regatta will be conducted on Saturday, July 29, 2017 between 8:30 am and 10:00 am. Execution of a **Liability Release Agreement** as set forth in the Registration Form shall be required. Parents are urged to provide a signed **Medical Consent Form** to enable other adults to obtain emergency medical services.

RULES: The regatta shall be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the rules of each class concerned (except as altered by the Sailing Instructions), the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The rules for all classes are altered so that membership in a class organization is not required. Sailing instructions will be provided at the registration and at the Skippers Meeting. The CSSA Arbitration will be used for all protests
