# NSA Board of Governors Minutes – January 2016

Commodore Andy Woodward called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

The December meeting minutes were approved: Zachary/Radabaugh

**Property Manager's Report:** P. Adams

–Lake level this morning 1422.29, .69 feet over pool.

–All boats but the Dolphin are out, and of course the Cat 27 hulk. This is great from a security standpoint.

–Our pressure washer performed great all season, but started to fail on the last boat taken out. Pump will need to go in for repairs over the winter.

–We have a problem with geese nibbling at the raw foam under the docks. This is a new development. It has never been this bad.

–I am not a goose behavioral psychologist. For some reason the flocks of geese have worked on our foam, generally at night and have caused significant and alarming damage in many places on A, B, and C docks. Not so bad on E. The Harbormaster and I did some on line research...

–Zodiac and Pontoon are at Wichita Marine for service, as well as the barge outboard. Purchased a quantity of outboard motor oil from Snyder's Marina at a deep discount.

–Had a couple of big private Holiday parties at the Afterdeck, no problems.

–Going over a list of maintenance items with the Past Commodore. Most pressing is a problem with the west end of the building: When it is really rainy and windy, out of the west-northwest, water comes in. We need to remove the log siding, replace the old tar-paper under it and see what else we need to do. Also add weatherstripping and a new cap to the entry doors. We have a bid from a reliable contractor for \$2500, labor and materials.

–We intend to clean out the basement. Anyone who has personal stuff there should take it home, and committee chairs who have materials there should get it consolidated and marked, or it may be recycled.

–Park staff has finished removing the old pit toilet and filled the excavated area in with sand, also repaired the roadway there with some good gravel. Work has begun

on a new sewage line to our facility, starting at the south end, ending at our bathhouse.

–I am still researching the best way to provide internet access for our facility. Our current surface microwave provider, Pixius, is at the margin of their service distance limits and may discontinue supporting their service to us. Other alternatives are being investigated.

**Administrative Secretary's Report:** A. Johnson

I have received about 25% of the member's dues so far and that is about normal for this time of year. Received a letter from D. Sim's mother wanting to know if NSA could transport his boat to Kaw Lake.

**Financial Report/Final Budget 2016:** S. Whiston-Fox/R. Leonard

It was decided to do away with the land line to the Afterdeck since cell phones are so prevalent now. This will save us about \$100/mo. Instructions will be posted regarding the alarm settings and what to do if it goes off. All the committees have submitted their final requirements and the 2016 budget is ready.
